Celtic Symbol Meanings



Celtic Cross

A Celtic Cross is a combination of a cross with a ring surrounding the intersection. Cross and circle symbols exist in all cultures. To the Druids, a plain circle was the moon and a circle with a cross inside was the sun. The cross represents the four directions and the four corners of the Earth. It also represents the vertical and horizontal coming together, or Heaven and Earth joined.

It is popular legend in Ireland that the Celtic Cross symbol was introduced by Saint Patrick. He combined

the pagan sun symbol
with the Christian
symbol of the cross. It
gave the pagans an idea
of the importance of the
cross by linking it with a
symbol that they
already worshipped.

High Crosses, or free
standing upright crosses
were carved from
standing stones of the
Druids. Some of them
still survive today. Many
stones from this period
are weathered, but the
best preserved ones
were often buried or
sheltered for many
years and protected
from damage. The most
famous standing crosses
are the Cross of Kells,
Ardboe High Cross, the
crosses at
Monasterboice, and the
Cross of the Scriptures.
